


Electrical safety outdoors


High voltage electricity on power lines can jump through the air - you don't have to touch anything to get a fatal shock, so:



Keep away from railway lines, the overhead power wires are just as dangerous as the trains.



Don't fly kites or carry tall objects like fishing rods near overhead wires.



Never attempt to climb pylons.



Never leave electric mowers or other power tools out in the rain - water conducts electricity.

It's easy being a bright spark... just get switched on to a few simple rules.



Don't touch a person who has had a shock until you have unplugged the appliance or you could get a shock too.
